The course features six, overlapping sessions that bring theory into real-life ministry application: (1) understanding the biblical framework for unity; (2) leading cross-culturally; (3) grounding ministry in love; (4) setting the table for multicultural ministry; (5) supporting mosaic communities and (6) preaching to a diverse audience.

Attendance Guidelines

Class attendance contributes to the success of your learning experiences at ANLI. As our courses run six weeks in length, you should attend all of them. Even one missed class sets you behind in your studies. Upon the second absence, you must drop the class and retake it another time. You cannot attend further sessions during that specific block. Three late arrivals or early departures of more than ten minutes, in any combination, equal one absence.

- The teacher cannot assign points from a missed class because of nonparticipation in the weekly, in-class Activities. Conversely, the instructor will deduct points for late arrival or early departure.

ASSIGNMENTS

1. In-Class Activities (Weekly—Up to 10 points each session)

You will receive participation points for each session. All students must fully prepare to engage in all class activities. <u>Missed in-class, on-line activities cannot be made up</u>. If you are late and/or leave early, the instructor will deduct participation points for that part of the session. Please feel free to video or audio record the session for your study purposes.

2. Reflections (Due Sessions 1-4--Up to 60 points each)

Please answer two of the weekly questions according to the course content and as a servant leader to be blessed as an elder at the Lighthouse Church of All Nations. Cite the quotes from the text and outside references in APA form. See the exemplar in the session one packet.

- **Text-to-Self.** Select a quote or thought from the assigned textbook reading that stood out to you as a leader in a M.O.S.A.I.C. church and explain how it informs your leadership practices.
- **Text-to-Text.** Compare and contrast a quote or thought from an outside writing on the multicultural or multiethnic church that relates to a quote from the assigned textbook reading.
- **Text-to-Ministry.** Analyze a particular local ministry issue that relates to the assigned reading.
- **Text-to-Global Christian Community**. Choose an issue from the broader Christian community related to the lesson topic and evaluate it based on the assigned readings and lesson materials.

3. M.O.S.A.I.C. Ministry Projects (Sessions 1-3—Up to 100 points each)

You will apply the M.O.S.A.I.C. competencies for unity in the Church in various project types.

4. M.O.S.A.I.C. Ministry Evaluation (Due session 5--Up to 125--Type)

You will analyze the ministry of which you participate in at Lighthouse Church of All Nations for evidence of applying the M.O.S.A.I.C. unity of the Church in three parts: 1) biblical tenets for unity; 2) M.O.S.A.I.C. competencies; and 3) internal and external actions for unity. Then, you will evaluate it according to spiritual growth measures in maturation, unity, favor, and numbers (Acts 2:42-47) and write recommendations for growth based on your observations and evaluations.

5. M.O.S.A.I.C. Leadership Self-Evaluation (Due session 5—Up to 75 points--Type)

You will self evaluate your leadership skills according to the M.O.S.A.I.C. competencies for unity of the Church found in the text keeping in mind the seven pillars of the servant of the Lord. Additionally Then, you will write a plan for growth based on your self-evaluation.

6. M.O.S.A.I.C. Illustrated Teaching (Due session 6—Up to 125 points)

You will teach a 15 minute, illustrated lesson about one of the course topics* based on the needs of the Lighthouse ministry of which you participate. Use the same ministry as you did for assignment four. Make sure you adapt the method to the message and meet the cultural background and learning styles of your ministry membership. Use engaged learning strategies in your lesson. Don't go under or over the allotted time.
