Instructional Overview

Big Ideas

- By using the three keys for effective witness upon the reliance of the Holy Spirit, one can evangelize the gospel in diverse situations.
- God hears the prayers of your loved ones.

Essential Questions

- What is intercessory prayer?
- Under whose authority do we operate?
- In what ways does our personal prayer life prepare and support us in effective evangelism?

Student Outcomes

- Self-evaluate evangelism experiences in small group
- Post a FB live prayer one-minute in length to the private group
- Practice and reflect upon two to three evangelism experiences outside of class based on the three keys to effective evangelism

How to Prayer Scripture at Walmart

Pray scripture/s over people according to the below scenarios.

- A man tells you he has cancer while you both stand in a long, long checkout line (Matt 8:13).
- A young man tells you in the parking lot that he's asked for prayer before, but it didn't work (Matt 9:28-29).
- A person contends that Allah is the supreme god (John 3:16; Phil 2:8-10).

Responding with Scripture

- A woman feels despondent because her husband just died. Integrate scripture into your response.
- You are looking at the fruit, and a man remarks to you that if God existed why did
 he let his mother die a long and horrible death. Integrate scripture into your
 response.
- A woman said she can't depend on anyone but herself. Integrate scripture into your response.
- A young, well-dressed man says he's done quite well for himself, and he doesn't need God. Integrate scripture into your response.
